Title: Fonds Armand Bergevin (AB)

Dates: 1926, 1944, 1951-1952, 1958, 1969, 1974 and 1992.

Extent of descriptive unit: 0.06 m of textual documents.

Administrative history or biography: Armand Bergevin was born on July 1, 1913, in Sainte-Martine, Qc. He was the son of Joseph Bergevin, a pioneer who settled on an agricultural lot in Glackmeyer Township, near Cochrane, in 1922. Armand bought the family farm in 1952 and became a farmer, while at the same time occupying various jobs. He was 99 years old, when he died, in Cochrane, in 2012.

Scope and content: The fonds contains legal documents relating to the purchase by Joseph Bergevin, in 1922, of an agricultural lot in Glackmeyer Township and to the sale of the farm to his son Armand, in 1952. Documents listing the Bergevin family's genealogy are also included.

Sources of information: Jean-Pierre Bergevin.

Physical description: The fonds includes one box of textual records.

Physical condition: Some textual documents are damaged.

Immediate source of acquisition: The fonds was acquired from Jean-Pierre Bergevin, in 2013.

Language: English and French.

Restriction on access: No restriction imposed by the donor.

Terms governing use and reproduction: Copyright Act applies. Reproduction permitted depending on the condition of the documents.
