Title: Collection Golden Citizen (TGZ)

Dates: 1996-1999.

Extent of descriptive unit: 0.65 m of textual records.

Administrative history or biography: The Golden Citizen was a free monthly publication “*focusing on the 55+ generation*” of the Timmins area. Directed by Rhéal Dupuis and published by the Northland Heritage Publications, in Connaught, the first issue was published in June 1996. The Golden Citizen presented articles on a variety of subjects including: interviews, historical testimonies, information relating to sports events and to those of special interest to seniors.

Scope and content: Incomplete, this collection includes newspapers published between June 1996 and November 1999.

Sources of information: "New paper for seniors", *The Golden Citizen* (Timmins), June 1996, p. 1.

Physical description: The collection contains a box grouping newspapers.

Immediate source of acquisition: The collection was acquired in 2015 through a donation from la Bibliothèque Maurice-Saulnier. New issues were added to the collection in 2022 following a donation from Katy Ginn.

Arrangement: The documents, once acquired, were organized by the archivist.

Language: English and French.

Restriction on access: No restriction imposed by the donors.

Terms governing use and reproduction: Copyright Act applies. Reproduction permitted depending on the condition of the documents.

Finding aids: None.

Associated materials: Newspapers and magazines found in the Collection des journaux et revues de la Grande Zone argileuse.
