**Title:** Collection Liaison

**Date:** 1978-2011.

**Extent of descriptive unit:** 0.55 m of textual documents.

**Administrative history or biography:** First published in 1978, Liaison is an art magazine, originally dedicated to the Franco-Ontarian culture. In 2005, it revised its mandate in order to include French cultural productions from l'Acadie and Western Canada. Liaison is published four times a year by Les Éditions L'Interligne; 1100 copies are issued per publication.

**Scope and content:** The collection consists of the complete series of the magazine Liaison in printed format.

**Sources of information:** Liaison website ([www.revueliaison.ca](http://www.revueliaison.ca)).

**Physical description:** The collection contains 119 volumes as well as 5 bound hardcover books.

**Immediate source of acquisition:** The collection, a donation from the Bibliothèque Maurice-Saulnier of the Université de Hearst, was acquired in 2013.

**Language:** The documents are written in French.

**Restrictions on access:** None.

**Terms governing use and reproduction:** Copyright law applies. Reproduction permitted according to the condition of the hardcover books or the magazines.

**Finding aids:** None.

**Accruals:** Further accruals expected.
